The Government of Mozambique received a loan from the **African Development Bank** toward the cost of the Niassa Provincial Towns Water Supply and Sanitation Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to eligible payments under the contract for the Consulting Services for the Detailed Design and Supervision of Works for a Rehabilitation and Extension of Water Supply System for Cuamba and Lichinga Cities.

The objective of the assignment is to develop a Detailed Design and provide Construction Supervision for rehabilitation and expansion of the system through a new intake, increase the reservoir capacities, a Water Treatment Plant and network expansion to the water systems of Cuamba and Lichinga.

The Fundo de Investimento e Património do Abastecimento de Água (FIPAG) now invites consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested firms must provide a statement of capacity and experience indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).
